Clyde Reed says this is most common in Livingston Co., Ky, near Paducah in low damp woods. He ^{also} saw it along a ditch just S. of Paducah.

The plant, a shrub, is about 3 ft tall.

We thought \$3 per pound might be reasonable.

Probably can be found across Ohio River in S. Illinois.
